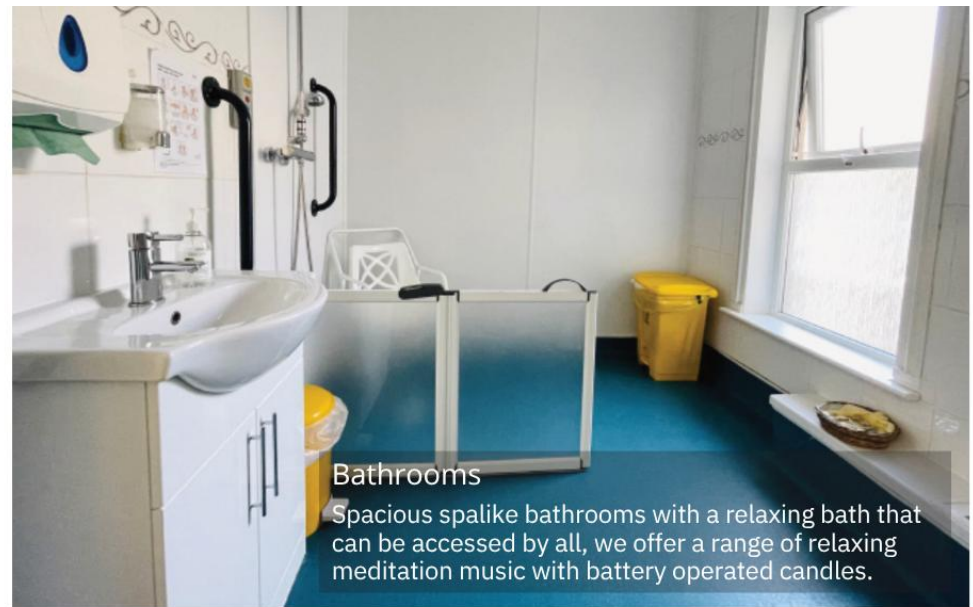
Life in our home
